Subgroup Data

- Required by QSAC to report on Subgroup data
- Lebanon Borough School has no groups that qualify as subgroups as per the definition including when all four NJSLA grade levels are aggregated. Typically we have male and female: however, last spring we only had 19 males take the assessment.
 - In New Jersey, a subgroup must have a minimum of 20 students for its assessment data to be reported separately for accountability purposes. This "n-size" ensures data privacy and reliability when evaluating subgroup performance in state assessments.

Next Steps

- Utilize NJSLA individual score reports and evidence statement reports in conjunction with mClass results, Benchmarks, and teacher/curricular assessments to guide instruction and develop plans for students with individual needs.
- Benchmarks and NJSLA scores were used along with teacher evaluations to determine students who may need further assessments. All students whose scores indicated a need to receive a remedial service (BSI/Special Svcs/etc.) were already receiving one.
- Utilize online platforms in Grades 3-6 to benchmark student progress and provide practice (mClass, Dibels, Reading and Math Program Assessments, Freckle, etc.).
- Identify and support students with Basic Skills as appropriate
- Continue to monitor progress through midyear and end of year benchmarks as well as classroom assessments
- Utilize NJSLA as initial screening tool for the AT program
