**Age Requirement:** Children must be five years old on or before August 15, 2022 to register for Kindergarten.

## REQUIRED Documents to Complete the Registration Process:

- Child's original birth certificate
- Child's immunization records to date
- 2 proofs of residency (i.e. driver's license, utility bill, construction/purchase agreement, rental agreement that shows current address)
- Custody Papers, if applicable

**Pennsylvania State Law requires each child entering school for the first time to have the following before school begins:**

- Immunizations: Diphtheria, Tetanus and Acellular Pertussis, Polio, Measles/Mumps/Rubella, Hepatitis B and Varicella (Chicken Pox Vaccine)
- A complete physical and dental examination: The physical examination will be accepted 6 months prior to school entry.
- The immunization requirements are a condition of attendance at any public, private, or parochial school in Pennsylvania. Parents/Guardians will be expected to produce evidence of the immunizations or their child will be denied entrance to school until the requirements are met.

## SUGGESTED Information to Provide at Registration:

- Child's Transportation Arrangements
- Medical Information (i.e. medications, allergies, special diet, etc.)

**What to expect at these Kindergarten events:** Parents/Guardians attending Orientation in February will meet school staff, learn about the school and pick up the registration packet. During in-person appointments in March, parents and students will rotate through stations, sometimes separate from each other. Parents will have the opportunity to provide copies of the necessary paperwork, while students work with teachers, reading specialists, speech pathologists and the school nurse to participate in screening activities.
