Lastly, thanks to the Tsehootsooi Medical Center for allowing us to host the festival and having the confidence in Ganado Unified School District.





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

INDIAN POLICY AND PROCEDURES SUMMARY

What is the IPP?

The IPP stands for <u>Indian Policy and Procedures</u>.
The purpose of the IPP is to:

- Ensure equal participation of Indian children in LEA's educational programs and activities
- Improve communication and cooperation between the LEA and Indian community.
- Involve parents and tribal officials in planning and developing educational programs and activities.

The IPP is a required document for the Impact Aid application. The Impact Aid provides a significant amount of funding for the district and GUSD does make a dedicated effort to ensure the application is submitted each year.

More information will be shared regarding the IPP during the summer and the fall.
